PROJECT OBJECTIVE

The main goal of the project under the name of "Renovation of the manor and park complex in Bieliny in order to extend the cultural offer of Ulanów Community" is enlarging of the cultural offer of the Ulanów community based on its heritage and local identity.

SUBJECT OF THE PROJECT

The project includes both infrastructural operations and soft activities which have been worked out together with the residents during the social consultations undertaken by the Beneficiary together with the Partner.

Completing the project will allow for increase in the representative function and tourism interest of the historical object being a sort of symbol – a monument of times past.

Municipality and Community of Ulanów:

Municipality and Community of Ulanów is responsible for undertaking the works of conservation, renovatory construction and installation in the historical manor in Bieliny, including planned construction works aimed at giving new functions to the antique manor, making use of the surrounding area.

The 19th-century manor is a two-storey building built of bricks, with multi-pitched roof covered with wooden rooftiles. The existing cellars may come from an earlier period. Currently the manor is in unfinished open state, has water, gas and electricity connections provided. Technical data of the building as follows:

- built-up surface area: 359.70 m²,
- useful surface area: 461.14 m²,
- total volume: 4323.44 m³,
- height of the building: 10,76 m,
- roof pitch angle: 33°.

In the adjoining park with the surface area of 4.21 hectares, fragments of a relic old growth of trees have been preserved, along with original features of english-style gardens with relics of french-style gardens. The park is located on a cliff and in a valley and with its antique objects is a dominant feature in the landscape of the village.

Within the park exists numerous old growth of trees and trees with monument value.

The Association "Bieliny – village over San river":

This Partner will not participate financially in the project. It will cooperate with the Municipality and Community of Ulanów and designated Operator at co-organizing the cultural, social and educational activities.

Cultural and educational offer:

The cultural events organized within the duration of the project are characterized by huge diversity when it comes to their form. The tasks included within the scope of the project have been divided into the following groups:

- Exhibition – it will be created on the ground floor in the Bieliny manor. The Exhibition of Manor Culture will be presenting the history of Bieliny and the noble houses whose representatives were ruling over these lands and left permanent traces in the local history. A mobile application will be created, providing a mobile guide over the exhibition part of the manor and the antique park together with the nearest area – the village of Bieliny, in which significant number of historical and antique objects is located.
- Events and meetings – including cyclical meetings promoting the local identity, tied to the history and the current events. In the antique sanctuary in Bieliny there is a chapel with over 100 relics of the saints, which has inspired the decision about organizing a cycle of meetings *"Polish Saints in service of the nation"*. Based on the rich history of insurgents and partizans, a lecture will be organized, titled *"In the footsteps of the partizans in the Ulanów Community"*.
- Concerts – one of the rooms of the manor and its patio is planned to be used for organizing chamber concerts and film projections. Within the duration of the project several concert meetings are being planned, including *"With music about music"*, proposed during the social consultations by the Culture Support Foundation "Amadeusz".

- Workshops – will be conducted in the cellar rooms of the manor. Workshops planned within the duration of the project will enable social integration of the participants and were suggested in the social consultations.
- Shows/exhibitions/integration meetings – it is planned to organize various events referencing other groups of events, from which all residents of the community can choose something for themselves. In connection to the exhibition presenting the history of Bieliny and the noble houses, it is planned to organize events promoting the manor culture – shows of the court dances and horse-riding. In the manor’s library chess meetings will be organized, as well as exhibition of photography, showing the works of the workshops’ participants. It is planned to build and strengthen the local identity based on the memories of the residents of Bieliny – the exhibition titled *”Let the memory live on”*. Similar is the goal of the socially-engaged theatre, performing interdisciplinary activities connecting the knowledge from areas of psychology, pedagogics, sociology, theatrology, anthropology of culture and others. Their outcomes are spectacles, usually based on real-life events of the community or participants, in various ways including the spectators in the work on issue presented in the performance, engaging the public and treating it as an integral part of the meeting.
- Multiculturality in the Ulanów Community – this group encompasses organization of cultural events promoting the Jewish culture, referencing the rich history of multiculturalism in the Ulanów Community. The offer of the events is dedicated to the residents of the community and most of them are not aimed directly at a specific age group. The goal of the varied activities being organized is informing and fostering interest among the residents regarding the new cultural location in the community, as well as reminding about the history and building the local identity. Only among the workshop activities the target groups have been split on the basis of age, according to their varied interests and differing scope and level of activities. There will be all-age workshops, as well as:
 - for children and youth – theater, handcrafting and photography workshops,
 - for the adults – theater and culinary workshops,
 - for the seniors – handcrafting and culinary workshops.

Within the duration of the project a series of training courses is being planned. There will be 6 types of professional training courses and 13 training courses about entrepreneurship and management in the culture. The planned training courses will allow for increase of qualifications and skills of the persons conducting the workshop activities within given topic. Their organization will enable increase of quality of the services provided by the Community Cultural Center and stems from events and workshops being planned within the duration of the project. The training courses will enable professionalization and increase in competence of the management personnel when it comes to managing a cultural institution, accessing external funds for cultural activities and management of projects. The task also includes purchases of equipment necessary for conducting the cultural activities and protecting the cultural heritage, not only in the renovated premises but also in newly provided spaces which have not been utilized for cultural goals before.
